## ***2012 Central Pacific Non-Qualifying Championships***

The 2012 Central Pacific Non-Qualifying Championships will be hosted by the Santa Rosa Figure Skating Club, Oct. 20 - 24, 2011, at Snoopy's Home Ice in Santa Rosa, CA. This competition is sanctioned by U.S. Figure Skating and all events will be conducted in accordance with the rules of U.S. Figure Skating as set forth in the 2011-2012 Rulebook, unless otherwise specified.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

Competitors must be current members of U.S. Figure Skating and have permission of their home club to enter. Eligible skaters from any region may enter to compete at the 2012 Central Pacific Non-Qualifying Championships. Competitors may be required to provide a birth certificate as proof of age, if requested. **Age and test requirements must be met as of the close of entries on Sept. 1, 2011.**

### **NON-QUALIFYING EVENTS**

The following events are offered:

**Basic Skating** – Levels 1-5

**Test Track free skate** – Limited Beginner Test, Beginner Test, Pre-Preliminary Test, Preliminary Test, Pre-Juvenile Test, Juvenile Test, Intermediate Test, Novice Test, Junior Test, and Senior Test

**Single free skate** – Pre-Preliminary No Axel, 10 & Under, Pre-Preliminary No Axel, 11 & Older, Pre-Preliminary 10 & under, Pre-Preliminary 11 & older, Preliminary 10 & under, Preliminary 11 & older, Pre-Juvenile, and Open Juvenile

\*For more specific information regarding required elements and further qualifications for Basic Skating, Test Track free skate, and Single free skate events, please see the detailed charts enclosed in this announcement.

\*All events in this non-qualifying competition will be judged under the 6.0 system. Events having a large number of entries may, at the discretion of the Chief Referee, be divided into groups by age as appropriate. No final rounds will be held and medals will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup> -4<sup>th</sup> place in each group.

## **VENUE**

The Redwood Empire Ice Arena- Snoopy's Home Ice, located at 1667 West Steele Lane, Santa Rosa, Calif., 95403 is the home rink for The Non-qualifying Competition held in conjunction with the 2012 Central Pacific Regional Championships. Snoopy's Home Ice has one surface, measuring 185 x 85 feet with slightly rounded corners. The judges will be seated on the side opposite the audience. There is one entrance door to the competition rink for parents and spectators and one entrance door for coaches and skater. Credentials or tickets will be required for admission. Practice ice sessions will be available.

## **ADMISSION / CREDENTIALS**

Entrance to the competition is by credential or ticket only and these are non transferable. Credentials and tickets for The Non-qualifying Competition may also be used for admission to events at the 2012 Central Pacific Regional Championships.

- \***Competitors:** Each competitor will receive a complimentary credential.
- \***Chaperone:** One complimentary chaperone credential will be provided for each skater.
- \***Coaches:** One coach credential will be provided for each skater at no charge. This credential will allow entry to all areas of the venue. Coaches must have completed the Coach Registration process (can take up to two weeks), be current U.S. Figure Skating members, and be Category B CER compliant.
- \***Additional coach or chaperone:** Each competitor may purchase one additional chaperone and one additional coach credential for \$30 each.
- \***Replacement:** Lost credentials may be replaced for \$30.

General admission to the competition is \$10 per day for adults and \$5 per day for children 5-12. Children under 5 are free. Day passes will be available for purchase at the rink on the same day as admission. All-event (multi-day) tickets may be purchased in advance or at the door for \$30 for adults and \$15 for children, ages 5-12.

## **REGISTRATION DESK**

A registration desk will be open in the lobby of Snoopy's Home Ice from Friday, Oct.20 through Monday, Oct. 24, 2011 during all practice and competition hours. Competitors must check in at the registration desk at least one hour prior to their scheduled event to turn in music and receive their credentials.

## **OFFICIAL BULLETIN BOARD**

During the competition, notices will be posted on the official bulletin board in the lobby at Snoopy's Home Ice. Information on this bulletin board supersedes all other official information and is considered sufficient notice to all competitors. It is the responsibility of the skater, coach, and parents to check this board frequently for changes to the schedule and other important information.

## **MUSIC**

Skaters must provide music in CD-R format on one track, clearly marked with his/her name, the event entered, and the music running time. Competition music must be turned in at the registration desk at the time of registration. Competitors will not receive their credentials until they have turned in their music. All skaters should have a backup CD readily available at practices and competition. Music that is not reclaimed at the registration desk by the close of competition will be discarded.

## **AWARDS**

Medals will be awarded for first through fourth place. **Results are not official until posted.** Medalists should appear in costume at the designated awards area for podium photos following the posting of results.

## **OFFICIAL PRACTICE ICE**

Official practice ice sessions will begin on Thursday, Oct. 20 and run through Monday, Oct. 24, 2011. **Each competitor may sign up for one official practice ice session.** Official practice ice sessions will run for 30 minutes and will take place on the competition rink. There will be a short warm-up period and then each skater with official practice ice that session will have his/her music played in order according to draw. These official practice ice sessions may be mixed with unofficial practice ice skaters, whose music will not be played, but will always be limited to a maximum of 12-15 skaters, depending on test level. Official practice ice sessions costs \$18 per session and can be reserved in advance using the attached **Practice Ice form.**

## **UNOFFICIAL PRACTICE ICE**

In addition to Official Practice Ice, Unofficial practice ice sessions will run, as time permits, Wednesday October 19 through Monday, Oct. 24, 2011. **Each skater may sign-up for up to two unofficial practice ice sessions each day.** Unofficial practice ice sessions will be assigned equitably and at times that are available. Unofficial practice ice sessions may be scheduled at the same time and on the same surface as official practice ice sessions. No music will be played. In the event of a purely unofficial practice ice session there is a maximum of 16 skaters. The cost per session of unofficial practice ice is \$15. These sessions can also be reserved in advance using the attached **Practice Ice form.**

Practice Ice will be provided by Santa Rosa Figure Skating Club, in accordance with the wishes of the Chief Referee. Practice Ice fees will not be refunded unless the requested session is not assigned. All practice ice sessions will be divided generally by test level.

At no time will qualifying and non-qualifying level skaters be mixed on practice ice sessions. The Practice Ice Schedule, assignments, and further information will be posted at the Central Pacific link at [www.srfsc.org](http://www.srfsc.org). Any additional practice ice time that becomes available may be purchased at a later date, or onsite on a first-come, first-served basis at the practice ice desk located in the lobby of Snoopy's Home Ice during the competition.

### **PHOTOGRAPHY/VIDEO**

Award photos will be taken as soon as possible following the posting of results. Individual or group podium photos may be purchased by competitors for a fee paid directly to the official event photographer, Brian Myers Photography. Personal photography is permitted for personal use only and resale of purchased photos is strictly prohibited. For the safety of the skaters, there is **no flash photography permitted**.

The 2012 Central Pacific Non-Qualifying Championships will be commercially videotaped. Skaters may purchase video of the performances directly from the videographer working the competition. Personal videotaping of the competition in any form is not permitted.

All competitors must submit the attached **Program Photo form** and a head/shoulders photograph for inclusion in the 2012 Central Pacific Regional Championships/ Non-qualifying Competition souvenir program. ## **TRANSPORTATION**

Visitors arriving by air have several choices of nearby airports. San Francisco International Airport is 77.05 miles south of Snoopy's Home Ice and the official hotel. Oakland International Airport is 68.94 miles south of Snoopy's Home Ice and the official hotel. Both airports are serviced by numerous major airline carriers. The Charles M. Schulz Airport is 6.84 miles north of Snoopy's Home Ice and the official hotel. The Charles M. Schulz Sonoma County Airport has somewhat limited service with flights provided by Horizon Air and Alaska Airlines. Several national chain rental car companies are located at each airport, and there are Shuttle and taxi services for ground transportation. Public transportation to and from the airport is not available.

## Test Track Free Skate

Skaters may enter EITHER the new test track free skate program or the well-balanced track free skate program but **NOT** both during the same non-qualifying competition. Competitors will skate to music of their choice, vocal music permitted. The 6.0 judging system will be used for all Test Track events.

Deductions **WILL** be made for skaters including technical elements not permitted in the event description.

- 0.1 from EACH mark for each technical element included that is not permitted in the event description.
- 0.2 from the technical mark for each extra element.
- 0.1 for any spin with less than required revolutions.
